## HOW TO RECYCLE

(Please Keep Schedule for Future Reference)

### PLASTIC:

*Acceptable* – rinsed, lids removed, clear and colored plastics with #1,2,3,4,5,6 & 7 stamped on bottom, milk and soap jugs, food, beverage and household cleaning bottles, plastic bags, potato chip bags, individual cheese wrappers.

### PAPER:

*Acceptable* – newsprint, letter quality paper, computer paper, magazines, advertising & books with glossy pages, colored typing paper

### GLASS:

*Unacceptable*

### CARDBOARD:

*Acceptable* – corrugated cardboard, boxboard, fiber board (i.e. packaging boxes, food boxes, beverage boxes, tissue boxes, paper towel rolls, etc.)

### TIN CANS:

*Acceptable* – tin can and aluminum foil containers

*Unacceptable* – aerosol cans and paint cans

### ADDITIONAL DIRECTIONS:

1. Please clean and rinse all containers. Remove all labels from tin cans.
2. Plastics may be flattened to save space.
3. Please DO NOT flatten tin cans.
4. Discard all container lids in garbage.
5. Fold cardboard into one by two foot sections.
6. Cardboard may be stacked next to container for pickup. If high winds are expected, please keep additional cardboard inside until a less windy day.
7. Please have recyclables curbside by 7:00 a.m.
8. No garbage or medical waste allowed in container.
9. Please keep the recycling material clean and dry.
10. Container remains the property of OC Sanitation.
